



Summer Camp Cancellation and Refund Policy

If FOTE cancels a camp

All camps must have at least 4 campers to run the camp. A camp is cancelled due to low enrollment two weeks beforehand. If your child is enrolled in a camp that Feet On The Earth cancels due to low enrollment, you can choose to switch into another camp, if there is space available, or receive a full refund.

Transfers

To request a transfer to a different camp, please e-mail info@feetonthearth.org with your child's name, and the names and dates of the camps you desire to transfer to and from. All transfers are dependent on availability. If desired camp is not available within the current year refer to cancellation policy. **Prior to May 15:** All camp registrations can be transferred at no cost. **After May 15 and up to 21 days prior to the camp start date:** Camp registrations can be transferred for a \$10 fee. **Within 20 days of the start of a camp:** Camp registrations can be transferred for a \$25 fee. **Within 7 days of the start of a camp:** Transfers will not be made; refer to the cancellation policy.

Cancellation

If you must cancel, please e-mail info@feetonthearth.org as soon as possible. **Prior to May 15:** Camp cancellations will receive a full refund less a \$35 administrative fee per camp. **After May 15 and up to 21 days prior to the camp start date:** Camp cancellations will receive a full refund less a \$35 administrative fee per camp, if we can fill the spot, or a 50% refund if we cannot fill the spot. **Within 20 days of the start of a camp** refunds will not be given.

Last-Minute Medical Transfer/Credit

In the event of illness or injury prior to the start of a camp please email info@feetonthearth.org as soon as possible. FOTE will transfer the camper to another available camp or issue a credit good for up to 1 year for a future program for the same camper for a \$35 administrative fee. A doctor's note stating the camper's inability to participate will be required. Requests for a medical cancellation will not be granted after a camp has ended.
